

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the English editing include?

Our extensive English editing service includes the following checks and corrections:

- Grammar
- Punctuation
- Sentence coherence and overall clarity
- Correct use of technical terms
- Figures checks and formatting
- References checks and formatting

Once the editing has been completed, we will send you two copies of your manuscript: one showing the changes and corrections made to your paper, and a clean copy.

We can also send you an editing certificate that you can send to your chosen journal, in order to show that your paper has already been professionally corrected for English language.

What does the Journal Selection include?

The Journal Selections consists of a selection of the four journals which best match your paper, and are therefore the most likely to accept your paper for publication.

For our selection, we also take account of your criteria, such as the databases in which your journal must be indexed, minimum impact-factor, journals or publisher you would like to avoid etc.

Do you include Open-Access journals in your Journal Selection?

We can of course include Open Access journals in your selection. Please write this as a note in the comment box during your online order. An Open Access article means that readers can freely access your paper, making it more easily citable. However, do bear in mind that Open Access publishers and journals will often ask for an Author Publishing Charge (APC) to cover their publishing costs.

What does the Pre-Submission Review include?

The Pre-Submission Review acts exactly like a standard publisher peer-review. It consists of 20 questions, which will help to determine how you can improve your paper and increase its chances of being accepted.

Our reviewer will give you concrete advice on what additional explanations, materials or tests might need to be included, which parts of your papers need to be revised etc.

Can you guarantee the publication of my research?
