

Programme Details

The MSc in Business Administration is delivered over four semesters. Providing a challenging and transformational educational experience for students.

The programme addresses both theory and practice as it seeks to enhance students' disciplinary and organizational knowledge. This experience will develop students' abilities to apply gained knowledge in simulated and real business scenarios.

Unlike many MSc in Business Administration programmes, there is a strong focus on Entrepreneurship & Innovation and NGM (Next Generation Management), helping to prepare our graduates to work in the industry.



Customisable Modules

Our flexible learning options allow us to tailor modules like; the 'Next Generation Management' module and the 'Delivering Performance Excellence' module, to suit the student's individual needs and experience level. The Next Generation Management (NGM) module provides you with the opportunity to develop the competencies required for successful management and leadership careers.

The NGM module focuses on four contemporary key themes:

While the 'Delivering Performance Excellence' module provides you with an enhanced understanding of the three dimensions of performance management in organizations, namely:

Entry Requirements



Academic Entry Requirements

- An Honors Degree from any discipline (or equivalent international qualification) Classification 2:2 (C);
- GPA minimum requirements: 3.75 out of 5 (equivalent to 2.75 out of 4).

However, students who earned an undergraduate GPA between 3.25 and 3.74 out of 5 (equivalent to 2.25 and 2.74 out of 4) are welcome to apply and will receive due consideration from the admission committee.

Language Entry Requirements

English is the language of instruction and assessment. Success in the programme requires a high level of English language proficiency. If English is not your first language and if your undergraduate programme was not taught and assessed in English, you will need to provide evidence of adequate English ability for admission. Such evidence includes:

• IELTS score (or equivalent) and an interview conducted in English.

General

Applicants must be female, as PNU is a university for women, and meet the visa requirements to study in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Apply as soon as possible. Admission is open on a rolling basis until capacity is reached.
