



Dress Code in Ceremonies

Choosing the right outfit for the time, place, and occasion is important for men and women as it makes a good impression.

Saudi National Costume for Men

- The appropriate color of the dress is important, and should it be dissonant, whether it is summer or winter.
- Avoid sheer summer dresses that are transparent, appear as a result of sitting and standing.
- The collar of the garment is always closed.
- There are occasions that require wearing Bisht, so choose the right color according to the occasion, time, and day. The way it is worn is
- Choose a fabric in which prominent cracks and zigzags do not the right hand inside and the left hand outside (Bisht), so that the tip can be held, and the right hand remains free to handshake and greet others.
- Black is the right color for the shoe for its formality. The color can be chosen in harmony with the color of the bisht or winter dress.
- White ghutra or red shemagh are the custom on formal occasions.

Saudi National Dress for Women

- Women wear modest clothing, whether the abaya or the headscarf to cover the entire body and hair, while being careful to avoid adornment and excessive wearing of accessories during her official participations representing the Kingdom.
- The shoes are a calm color, medium height, and do not cause striking and annoying sounds while walking.
- As for the handbag, there is a protocol for how to carry it and where to put it during meetings and events, for example, it is hung on the left shoulder, and if it is small, it is held with the left hand so that the right hand is free to shake hands. Its colors are considered to fit with the general dress.
- Finally, civilized societies are averse to exaggerating the way and value of clothing and accessories.
